Amount: \$500.00

<u>Requirements:</u> Scholarships are open to students between the ages of 18-25 who are experiencing financial needs in pursuit of higher education and or a trade.

To qualify for the scholarship, applicants must have a financial need, be between ages of 18 to 25, and be in pursuit of a trade certificate, associate, and or bachelor's degree.

Applicants must reside in Tennessee or Mississippi and are currently enrolled or have been accepted into an accredited college or trade program in TN or MS. <u>Top qualifiers are required to complete a</u> virtual interview by July 21, 2024.

Application Checklist:

- 1. Completed application form (2 pages)
- 2. Personal statement page (include need for scholarship/hardship, attach additional pages if needed)
- 3. Two Letters of Recommendation
- 4. Minimum GPA of 3.0 submission of unofficial transcript accepted. High school students submit final HS transcript and enrollment letter from college or university
- 5. Documentation of at least 10 community service hours from the past six months (letter from company with signature/contact information)
